
## Horizontal

### ➔ Improvements

Replacement of a split CHED is now possible.

Previously, it was not possible to replace a split CHED. The workaround was to cancel the faulty CHED and to split again the initial CHED.

With this improvement it is now possible to directly replace a split CHED. A hyperlink between the replacing and replaced CHED will be displayed:

Uploading an empty file inside the Accompanying Document field now triggers an error

This improvement was implemented to prevent the uploading of an empty document which induced an infinite loop of file verification. From now on, when an empty file is uploaded in that field, TRACES will discard the empty file and display an error message to notify the user. The certificate won't be submitted as is unless a proper file is uploaded.

### Possibility to refresh the certificate model that has changed status

When a certificate model is updated, certificates that were already prepared using the old version can be refreshed. The system will display a message with a link and a button, allowing the users to load the latest revision of the same certificate model from TRACES NT.



## Possibility to initiate and fill in a certificate using a certificate model that is not yet “Active” in TRACES

With this improvement it is possible to initiate and fill in a certificate with certificate model that has a status “Upcoming” and save as New or In Progress. Given the ‘upcoming’ status of the certificate, the system will not allow its finalization.



## Enhanced BCP Specifications Management in TRACES

Technical users managing BCP (Border Control Post) information in TRACES can now enter additional specifications when the "Specifications" field is set to (1). These additional details are supported as multilingual translations, with English being mandatory. This update ensures more precise and standardized BCP information across different languages, improving data consistency and usability for international stakeholders with respect to the publicly available lists of BCPs details that are published by Member States authorities.



## Forgetting the issuing Country of the Accompanying Document field triggers an error

In all CHED and NoA, EU IMPORT, EU EXPORT and EU INTRA, COI and CATCH. The country of issuance of the document is now mandatory.

## Cloning an EU INTRA to an EU EXPORT and vice-versa

**Context:** For exports of live animals to certain non-EU countries, certain EU harmonised models of EU EXPORT certificates are available in TRACES. In case of transit between EU countries before the exit from the EU, an INTRA certificate is also required in accordance with Animal Health Law rules.

A cloning function allowing to transfer the encoded information between an EU INTRA to an EU EXPORT and vice-versa has been enabled to facilitate the completion of these certificates by operators and authorities.

Moreover, in the TRACES interface, both certificates will display a hyperlink:

However, in the case of the cloning of the EU EXPORT certificate for horses, depending upon the nature of the equidae, registered or not registered, a further sorting might be necessary in a second step, using the re-assign button.




### Search functionality for the cloned EU INTRA and EU EXPORT certificates

## Frequency of Check information now displayed in CHED search screen

A new feature has been developed to display information about frequencies of checks applicable in a CHED, when relevant. This will take the form of a light blue box displaying the rate of checks applicable (see red boxes below), as well as a yellow caution sign to indicate that the consignment has been selected by the system for Identity and Physical checks (see green arrow below).

This information is available to BCP users when their BCP is the entry authority in charge of the document in question.


All CHED documents now feature the possibility to indicate up to three decimals for the value of the net weight in the commodity description field. This brings the available precision for this value to the milligram.

It is now possible to select or create a non-EU transporter in box I.17 when boxes I.26 "transit through Third Country" and I.28 "Export" are activated or if a non-EU operator is mentioned in box I.13 "Place of destination".

For box I.16 "Means of transport", any country can be selected, and creation is possible for all countries, regardless of if the boxes I.26 "transit through Third Country" and I.28 "Export" are activated or not and if a non-EU operator is mentioned in box I.13 "Place of destination".



ePhyto results now cover entire specified date

Previously, when searching for ePhytos in the main Phyto search screen, the seconds were not taken into account in the date range. For example, a range set from 05/11/2024 00:00 to 05/11/2024 23:59 was interpreted as 00:00:00 to 23:59:00, excluding the last minute.

This issue has been resolved: the system now automatically includes the full last minute (23:59:59) even if seconds cannot be specified manually in the date picker.






Previously, users have reported difficulties determining whether they are copying a Phyto or copying a Phyto for re-export when using the 'Copy as New' functionality.




#### Selection of CN code even if the code falls under a CHED-D Regulation

This improvement allows for the selection of a commodity code for NoA even if the same code falls under the scope of CHED-D regulations: 2019/1793, 284/2011, 2020/1158, & 2011/884

A fix has been developed to address the issue of incorrect document selection when the scope of a CN code/Country of origin combination overlaps between NoA and CHED-D. Previously, due to the overlapping scope of certain commodity codes (e.g., 22029919 used both for fruit juices containing and not containing wild fruits of the genus Vaccinium from certain countries of origin mentioned in reg. 2020/1158), the system was unable to distinguish between when a NoA or a CHED-D was required and was defaulting to requiring the creation of a CHED-D.

This issue has been resolved by the addition of an attribute which will allow the selection of **either document** in the cases of a CN code/Country of origin combination with an overlapping scope, as seen in the example below:





A new specific “authorised for transfer” notification has been developed so that the authority of a Control Point selected in the CHED gets notified when a consignment has been accepted for transfer and it is on its way. If no authority is selected in the CHED, no notification is sent.

#### CHED - Harmonized seal number validation after inspection (II.19) in WS and GUI

It is now possible to send a "New seal number" after resealing from inspection (II.19) via Web Services, even when no container is registered (Box I.17). This behavior is now aligned with the TRACES GUI. To do so a new schemaID will be used for the container number and that is "container\_number\_resealed\_only". The update is reflected in the WS CHED V2 documentation.

#### COI - Enabled COI Classification Tree retrieval via WS for Control Body users

Web Services users linked to a Control Body (CB), can now access the `getClassificationTree` method with input "coi" to retrieve CN codes for use in Box II.1 (Directory of products) on the COI certificate. This change aligns WS behavior with the GUI version of OOC.

## Establishment Amendments Lists


### ➔ Improvements

A maximum of 50 entries is now allowed for the creation of an Establishment Amendment List

In the process of managing establishment lists in TRACES by non-EU countries, it was observed that the system enforces a maximum of 50 approved entries per list.

When creating a list, it is possible to select up to 50 operators without any issue.

However, upon attempting to add a 51st operator, the "+Add establishment" button became inactive (in grey colour), indicating that the system has a strict limit of 50 operators per list:



In addition, also a pop-up message appears under the reference number of the list indicating that a maximum number of establishments has been exceeded:



In conclusion, the system allows the relevant authorities to finalize the list with 50 entries, whether all under the same activity (e.g., all 50 entries in **LBM - Live bivalve molluscs** activity) or with different activities (e.g., **FFP - Fishery products** and **HON - Honey activities**) within the same chapter (e.g., food).

At the same time, the system enables the competent team to complete the list review and successfully publish the list.





### Preventing Deletion of Operators with Valid Activity/s or with an ongoing Amendment Lists

Previously, certain operators were incorrectly marked as “Delisted” while there were ongoing amendment lists in progress, or the amendment list has been published after that the only activity valid existing in the operator has been deleted. This led to situations where operators were deleted despite still having a valid activity:



### What's New:

- **Prevention of deletion when there is an ongoing Amendment List:** The system has been updated to prevent an operator from being automatically deleted if there is an ongoing amendment list in progress. This ensures that operators are not deleted while still undergoing changes or updates.
- **Improved operator status handling:** Operators with pending amendments will no longer be marked as deleted until all changes are fully processed, preserving valid activities and preventing inconsistencies.


This update ensures that operators are not deleted prematurely, **especially with the new functionality**, where lists — following the removal of an activity from an approved establishment by the competent authority — are automatically published **without prior examination by the relevant SANTE policy Units**. This update improves the integrity of operator data and prevents confusion about the operators' listing status.

### Prevention of Deletion of Means of Transports linked to registered transporters

Means of Transports (MOT) that are linked to registered transporters cannot be deleted anymore.



## Changes to the advanced authority search

Several updates have been done to improve the advanced search options for searching authorities:

1. Status of the authority can now be selected
2. The search results can be displayed as a list (= the classical view) or as a tree:



When displaying the search results in a tree-view, the searched authority is displayed inside its authority hierarchy – including all the levels of superior authorities and the searched authority is highlighted:


**NOTE:** not all the above-mentioned changes are in place for all BCPs at the date of the release, but will be implemented gradually, when updating the individual entries in TRACES. Additionally, as any other changes to authority entries in TRACES, the new information cannot be updated by the countries' competent authorities but must be communicated to the TRACES Support team.

These additional options aim to enhance the display of information in TRACES but are not linked to any 'background' rules that influence the selection of the correct BCPs inside the documents in TRACES. The selection of the correct authority still remains the responsibility of the user completing a document.




## User Profile Settings

### ➔ Improvements

#### Changes to the selection of notifications the users receive


The notification subscriptions settings have been enhanced to allow users to fine-tune the desired level of notifications, with a clearer presentation of the different sections and a possibility to enable or disable in bulk by section. The settings for in-app and email notification are now independent. The settings also offer the possibility to opt out the default display of notification pop-ups, which are often numerous and cover a significant amount of the screen when they pop out. The settings are accessible through the same Edit Profile button from the interface found at the top right corner of the screen.

On the user profile page, the notifications have been sorted by topics/modules – when accessing the user page all topics/modules entries are automatically expanded:




NOTE: the list above can vary in length, depending on a user's domain. A competent authority for the animal chapter for example will not see the notification lists that don't fall under the animal section.

At the top of the list, users have the option to unsubscribe from all emails and/or in-app notifications. Additionally, it is possible to select or unselect the individual notifications inside each of the lists:





When users have selected the preferred notification types, they need to select the preferred timeslots (which are indicated in Brussels time):



An additional option to remove or show the blue pop-up notifications is also provided. This adds or removes the blue notification pop-ups that sometimes block the rest of the view. If the “Show notification pop-up” box is not ticked as in the screenshot above, the pop-ups don’t appear.

If the box is selected, the in-app notifications the user selected earlier will also appear as the blue pop-up messages:




