
1 New major features

1.1 Replace / cancel rejected CHED:

It is now possible to replace or cancel rejected CHED. Previously these actions were only possible on Validated CHED. This feature has been enabled as it was anyway possible to "Copy as new" and do a new CHED for the consignment. Allowing the replacement / cancellation of a rejected CHED allows to keep track of the information and link documents together.

1.2 New status:


CHED signed for transit now have a specific status:


2.1 Searching a CHED by commodity code (advanced search filter) now works as expected.



2.2 Box I.4 "Border Control post": The box is renamed in "Border control post/ control point/ control unit" to align with OCR. In case of workflows generating a subsequent CHED, such as "Transfer to" or "Onward Transportation", the authority of the CP / OTF of selected in the **first** CHED populates box I.4 on the **subsequent** CHED.



- **2.3 Box 1.7 "Place of destination":** The box has been reworked to allow the selection of a BCP, Onward transportation facility, or Control point in some specific workflows:
 - Entry BCP in case of splitting/ unloading at the BCP;
 - Onward Transportation Facility (when CHED authorized for OT);
 - Control Point when "Transfer to CP"




- **2.4 Box 1.9 "Accompanying document":** Date of issue is not a mandatory field anymore in order to align with Annexe II of IMSOC.
- **2.5** Box **I.17** "Container N°/ Seal n°": It is now possible to tick "Official seal" if relevant. Position of container and seal fields have been swapped to correspond to the PDF model.





2.6 Box 1.20 "For transfer to": The box has been reworked. The control point is now selected regardless it corresponds to premises of an operator or of an authority.

TEMPORARY for version 4.2.0: when several authorities are responsible for the Control Point, the user creating the first CHED need to select one of these authorities. Only the selected responsible authority of the CP can initiate the subsequent.



A patch 4.2.1 will come soon after 4.2.0. It will not be required anymore to select one authority when several authorities are responsible for the Control Point. All the authorities of a CP will be able to initiate the subsequent.


With version 5.0.0 the subsequent CHED will be initiated by the responsible for the consignment as they have the obligation from the OCR to pre-notify the arrival of a consignment.

- **2.7 "Transfer to":** As authority at Control Point doing the subsequent CHEDPP I can now correctly open the PHYTO cloned by the first CHED.
- **2.8 Reduced frequency %:** In a subsequent CHED, the reduced frequency percentages displayed on top of Part II now correctly consider the data of the country of the subsequent



CHED. Previously if the first CHED was initiated in Spain, and the subsequent was done in France, the % in the subsequent CHED were wrongly showing numbers of Spain.


- **2.9 Box II.5 "Physical Check":** It is now possible to select the reason why the physical check has not been done.
 - Tick 'Reduced check' where, in accordance with the rules to be adopted pursuant to Article 54(3) of Regulation (EU) 2017/625, the consignment has not been selected for identity and physical checks but is considered to have been checked satisfactorily with documentary check only.
 - Tick 'Other' where re-entry, monitoring, transit procedures are referred to. This also refers to goods that are transhipped from one BCP to another BCP in accordance with the rules to be adopted pursuant to point (b) of Article 51(1) of Regulation (EU) 2017/625.





2.10 Part III: Modification of the part III "Follow-up" of the CHED.

- Boxes III.4 and III.5 have been merged into one radio button list, which expands with
 the additional info to provide depending on the choice. Switching selection erases any
 entries made.
- Box III.4 is used in case the commodity are re-dispatched (e.g. after rejection)
- **Box III.5** is used to acknowledge the arrival of the consignment or to report noncompliance at the second place where controls will be finalized (Control Point, BCP, Onward transportation facility,...).



2.11 Quality control: fixing an issue where user was brought back to Part II and had to fill in QC tab again.

3.1 Box 9 "Container N° / Seal n°": It is now possible to tick "Official seal" if relevant. Position of container and seal fields have been swapped to correspond to the PDF model.
