

Operator management - Introduction of new sections of Approved or Registered Animal Transporters under the veterinary chapter


Version 5.8.11 of TRACES NT enables the creation of approved or registered Animal Transporters under the new transporters' sections of the veterinary chapter:

- Registered Transporter (Registered transporters (under AH rules) to which AW rules do not apply);
- Transporter Type I (Type I authorised transporters to which AW rules do apply);
- Transporter Type II (Type II authorised transporters to which AW rules do apply).

When creating a new transporter the new sections can be selected by following the steps indicated below:

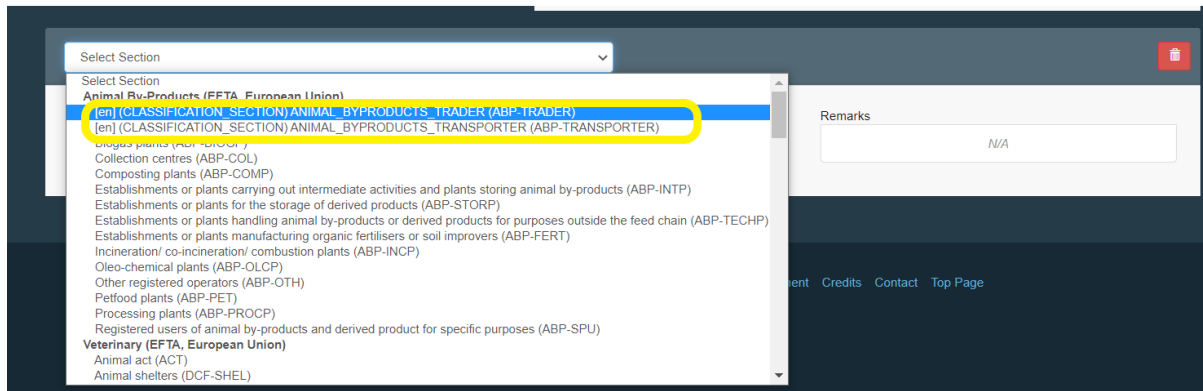

The sections ABP-Transporter and ABP-Trader have been added under the Animal By-products chapter:



All document types - New copy functionality for commodity descriptor rows applicable to all modules


In version 5.8.11 of TRACES NT, a new function has been enabled which applies to all modules.

The new copy functionality appears in the box where the description of the consignment has to be filled in (the number of the box can vary according to the type of document/certificate):




The new functionality allows to copy a commodity row, that has already been inserted and filled in, to a new commodity row with the same information.

To do so, a new button has been placed to the right part of the commodity row (highlighted in yellow in the following screenshot):



Once you click on that button, a new line with the exact same information (such as Country of Origin, Product type, etc.), will be created under the existing one:




PHYTO - PDF layout adaption

The PDF layout of the phytosanitary certificates has been modified in accordance with the model set out in the Plant Health Law (Regulation (EU) 2016/2031) whilst ensuring closer alignment with the IPPC model.



The modifications are as follows:

- The EU logo now appears in box 5 of the PDF of phytosanitary certificates when the issuing NPPO country is in the EU (PHYTO for export).
- The vertical box “Certificate” has been removed.
- The country of origin has been removed from the top of the phytosanitary certificates.
- The boxes 5, 6 and 7 have been switched so that they are closer aligned to the IPPC model.
