➔ Spain and France added to the list of “third countries” in boxes I.22 transit and I.20 transshipment.

The selection of Spain and France has been enabled in the list of “third countries” in boxes I.22 transit and I.20 transshipment.

This change was implemented in order to comply with article 1, point 3, of Regulation 2016/2031, which states that Ceuta (ES), Melilla (ES) and the territories that are referred to in Article 355(1) TFEU (except for Madeira and Azores) should be considered “third countries” for plant health rules.

When consignments of plants and plant products transit Union territory towards one of these territories, following this improvement it will be possible to indicate whether it is a French or Spanish territory:



Certified Drivers/Attendants


➔ Possibility to select both: Certified Driver and Certified attendant

The possibility has been made available to mark an entry under the Certified Drivers/Attendants as driver AND attendant. To do so, select the option “Both” in the first box:
