




## EU EXPORT: Box I.8 Region of origin

The completion of Box I.8, Region of Origin, has been enabled for use in Export certificate models. To complete it, the relevant region of origin information needs to be filled in the Description of Consignment, box "Region of Origin"



Once that box is filled-in, the box I.8 will be automatically populated from the information indicated in box I.28 Description of Consignment. This is a free text box, and any region of origin indicated in this box will be saved in the system's memory and it will be selectable again in the future.



**NOTE:** the information on the region of origin will only be displayed in box I.8 of the PDF version of the certificate, not in the description of consignment.

The relevant box in the description of the consignment will only be displayed in the online interface as this is the technical tool to populate the region of origin information in box I.8.

## CHED-D and CHED-P: Enabling of new types of accompanying documents in box I.9

In accordance with the requirements of Implementing Decision 2011/884, the accompanying documents “Health certificate 2011/884, “Analytical Report 2011/884” and “Statement 2011/884” were added to the list of selectable Accompanying documents in both CHED-D and CHED-P.

## EU EXPORT & EU INTRA bug fix: Text overflow in PDF

The issue concerning the wrong PDF display of Part II in certain INTRA and EU EXPORT certificates where text was displayed outside of the margins of the page has been addressed.
