Part II: Certification	I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that:			
	II.1.	The animals in the consignment described in Part I meet the following requirements in any stage of their lifecycle, including honeybee brood:		
	II.1.1.	The animals have not shown signs of occurrence of American foulbrood, <i>Aethina tumida</i> (Small hive beetle) and <i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp. during the visual examination carried out within the 48 hour period prior to departure.		
	II.1.2.	Their packaging and any accompanying feed or other material have not shown signs of presence of American foulbrood, <i>Aethina tumida</i> (Small hive beetle) and <i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp. during the visual examination carried out within the 48 hour period prior to departure.		
	II.2.	According to official information, the animals meet the following animal health requirements:		
	II.2.1.	The animals come from an apiary situated in the centre of a circle of at least 3 km radius where American foulbrood has not been reported during the 30 day period prior to departure and which is not restricted due to an outbreak of American foulbrood;		
	II.2.2.	The animals come from an apiary situated in the centre of a circle of at least 100 km radius, where infestation with <i>Aethina tumida</i> (Small hive beetle) and <i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp. has not been reported and which is not restricted due to a suspected case or the confirmed occurrence of infestation with <i>Aethina tumida</i> (Small hive beetle) or <i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp.

	II.3.	To the best of my knowledge and as declared by the operator, the animals in the consignment come from an establishment where there were no abnormal mortalities with an undetermined cause and they have not been in contact with honeybees, which did not comply with the requirements referred to in point II.2.		
	II.4.	This certificate is valid for 10 days from the date of issuing. In the case of transport by waterway/sea of animals, the period of 10 days for the validity of the certificate may be extended by the duration of the journey by waterway/sea.
